


Living Faith Covid-19 Protocol



COVID-19 is an unprecedented time for worshipping together and so much more. Here at Living Faith Community Presbyterian Church we want to ensure the safety of our congregation while we worship together. In order to do so we have created some guidelines that will enable us to open our doors starting Sunday, September 6th, 2020. With your help we can do this safely.

Step 1

Please email or call the church to let us know that you will be attending. This will make it easier for us to ensure that physical distance measures will be in place upon your arrival. However, if you are unable to do so you will still be admitted. If our sanctuary reaches COVID capacity Celebration Hall will be available for overflow.

Step 2

A greeter will be present upon your arrival and you will be asked to wear a mask for the duration of the service that covers both your mouth and nose. After you have answered the following questions and confirmed there is no risk of COVID-19 your name will be confirmed on our attendance list you may proceed to enter the building. The questions are as follows:

1. Have you travelled outside of Canada or had close contact with anyone that has travelled outside of Canada in the past 14 days?

2. Do you have a fever?

3. Have you had close contact with anyone with respiratory illness or a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19?

Step 3

An usher will direct you to a seating area in the sanctuary. We will be filling the sanctuary from front to back to ensure physical distancing is in place.

If you have any prayer requests, please give them to the usher. Requests will be collected and read during the service.

During the service we ask that you do not move around and refrain from visiting.

Sunday School has been canceled but nursery care will be available. Bins with activities will be available for families with school age children upon entry to the sanctuary. 1 bin per family.

Childcare drop off will be at nursery door, please promptly pick up your child directly after the service.

Singing is prohibited in accordance with Health Unit regulations.

The offering will not be formally collected during the service but can be left as you exit in the offering plates located just inside the doors at the back of the sanctuary.

Step 4

At the end of our service and usher will direct you to leave the sanctuary in order to keep social distancing. Please go directly outside after the service. If you need to use the washroom facilities, please be mindful that only one person is permitted at a time. There will be no refreshments served as per the Health Unit.
